The joint, combined, and interagency orientation of NMIA is increasingly relevant as our nation deals with threats to our homeland.

NMIA was established in 1974 as a U.S. Army professional association. It evolved quickly into an organization to provide a professional forum for intelligence professionals in all the military services, intelligence agencies, offices of the U.S. Government, industry, and academia to share ideas for their individual professional enhancement and the good of the Intelligence Community.

## **New Membership or Renewal**

NMIA membership is available to military and civil service personnel, as well as to Reserve, National Guard, retired former service personnel, and to U.S. civilians in the industrial sector and law enforcement arena supporting the U.S. intelligence system.
